

Purpose of the Study

The purpose of the 9th Street Improvement Plan is to develop strategies for improving the operation of 9th Street for vehicles, pedestrians, bicyclists and transit services.

The objectives of the Project are:

- 1) To improve the operation of 9th Street for vehicles, pedestrians, bicyclists and transit services;
- 2) To develop a 9th Street Improvement Plan that guides future developments, and;
- 3) To incorporate the 9th Street Improvement Plan into the City of Corvallis Development Code for implementation.

Project Background

- The 1996 City of Corvallis Transportation Plan recommended a study of 9th Street to improve safety and access management
- In 2007, CAMPO received a Transportation & Growth Management (TGM) grant to complete the study
- The project is being developed, under the guidance of a Project Advisory Committee made up of local leaders & business owners
- Project scheduled for completion in December, 2009
- Plan recommendations are intended for incorporation into the Corvallis Development Code

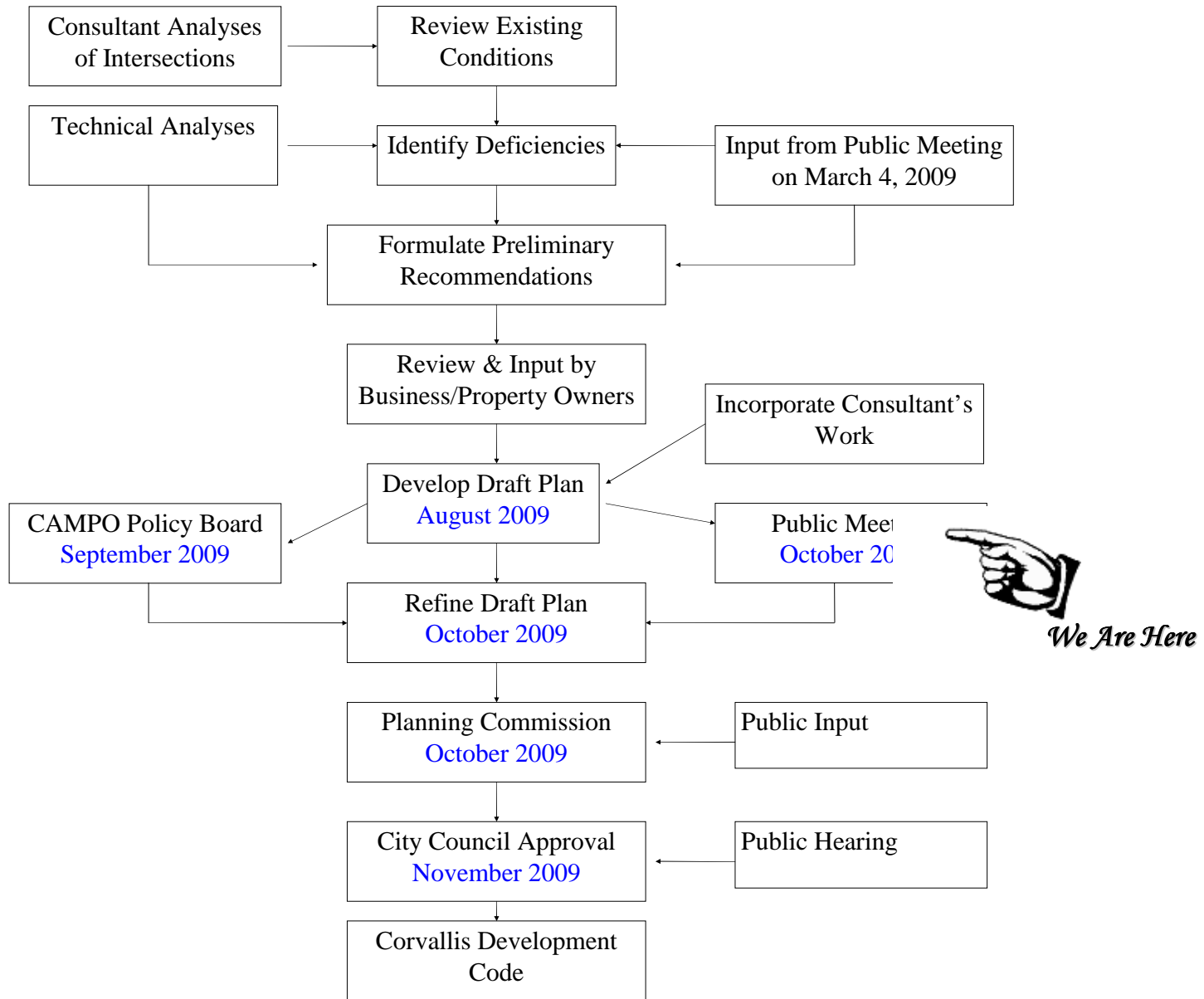

The Corvallis Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) is an association of local governments designated by the Oregon Governor in December 2002 to make transportation planning and programming decisions for the Cities of Corvallis, Philomath and Adair Village as well as the parts of Benton County adjacent to these cities.

The CAMPO Policy Board is made up of representatives from the Benton County Board of Commissioners, City of Corvallis, City of Philomath, City of Adair Village and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT).
