

Corvallis Area Metropolitan Transportation Plan: Destination 2030

Who?

An association of local governments made up of representatives of Benton County, cities of Corvallis, Philomath and Adair and Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) have been designated by the Oregon Governor as the Corvallis Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO). The newly designated organization is in charge of transportation planning and programming for the Corvallis Urbanized Area (See the attached Map of the Urbanized Area).

What?

CAMPO has launched development of a transportation plan for the entire Corvallis Urbanized Area. Currently Benton County, Corvallis and Philomath have a transportation plan. The intention is to combine all the existing plans into a regional one that would also cover Adair Village.

How?

A great deal of good work has gone into the existing TSPs. This work should be honored. Through its public involvement efforts, CAMPO intends to combine the existing transportation system plans (TSPs) into one that covers the entire Corvallis Urbanized Area.

What is the Status?

A *Public Involvement Plan* that outlines participation of the general public and stakeholders in this process has been developed. Staff also has reviewed the visions and goals of the transportation and land use plans in the area and has identified their common elements. These documents have been posted at the CAMPO Website: www.corvallisareampo.org

What is Next?

A Public Meeting will be held on November 17, 2004 to seek public input into the draft vision and to identify issues to be addressed by the Transportation Plan. This Public Meeting is broadly advertised through the media and direct mail. The chairpersons of the transportation-related committees, referred to as the Ad hoc Committee, will review the public input and assist with formulating the goals, transportation scenarios and development of the final plan. The holding of public meeting and the meetings of the Ad hoc Committee will be repeated two more times during the completion of the Plan. The Plan is scheduled for adoption by the CAMPO Policy Board in September 2005.
